The Belgians and the Spanish hosted in Pulawy

Niepubliczne Gimnazjum combined with the Ist Liceum named after Prince Adam Czartoryski was the host partner for the group of Belgian and Spanish youth and their teachers over the period of 25th - 28th May. The stay at our school was an integral part of the Comenius Project which initiated in autumn last year and will have been carried out until June 2012.

The theme of the project ‘Are you a CO₂ consumer?’ is thought to pay attention towards environmental issues but especially recycling materials – themes which should be educated to our society since the early age.

Based on a large number of activities which have been undertaken since the project initiated the international youth members have already managed to present their own song recording based on Michael Jackson’s ‘Thriller’ converted into own lyrics about ecological issues, designed own project logo, made own survey and then worked on the analysis of it, made several leaflets and posters reflecting ecological warning, made musical instruments and flowers out of recycled materials. Our activities have already been highly appreciated by the visiting representative of the National Agency in Warsaw.



It is important that the youth of the participating countries have a chance to develop their communicative English language skills. The fact that the partners are hosted by the participants' host families adds to the value of breaking cultural and national stereotypes. Our three day visit programme included participation in some of the school classes on subjects chosen (Polish, English, Maths and Physical Education), sightseeing tour of Pulawy and Kazimierz Dolny which ended up with a bonfire and a reception prepared by the parents of the host families and partners.

During the stay the group received a warm welcome at the Commune Office of Pulawy by the local authority – Mr Witold Popiolek and the secretary Ms Teresa Kot.
